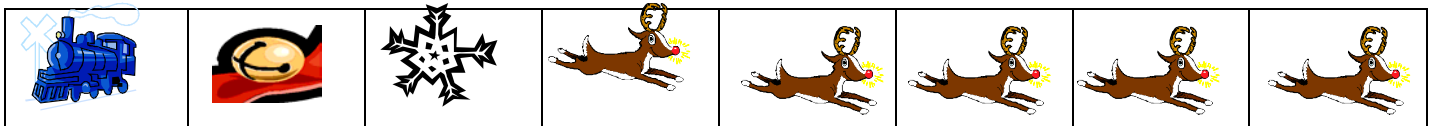

Winter is here! Let's graph the winter objects. Cut each object out and glue it to the correct space on the graph.

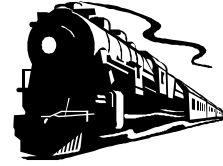
