

Holy Thursday – The Church Recalls Jesus’ Last Supper with his disciples.

Good Friday – Jesus’ suffering and death on the cross is remembered

Holy Saturday – A day for Prayer and waiting to celebrate Jesus’ Resurrection

Pentecost – 50 days after Easter.

Lent – preparation for the celebration of Easter lasting 40 days. A time of retreat.

Resurrection – The event of Jesus’ being raised from death to new life by God the Father through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Apostles – The First 12 Leaders called by Jesus

Easter Vigil – Celebrated in Holy Saturday Evening. New members are welcomed into the Church.

Gospels – The Four Books in the New Testament that tell the stories of Jesus’s life, death, and Resurrection.

grace – God’s free and loving gift to humans of his own life and friendship.




Holy Trinity – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – The three persons in God.

This is what Judas took for betraying Jesus.




Jesus used this at his last supper with his disciples

What was hammered into Jesus's hands and feet?




Used to gamble for Jesus's clothing.
