Note To Teacher: Here is a book about the color green. Have your students color the pictures and finish the sentence with a yes or no and the color of the object. They may then cut the pages and staple to form their book.

For example, page one would say: Is the grass green? Yes, the grass is green. Page two would say: Is the banana green? No, the banana is yellow.






